Hearing aid controls



Hearing aid batteries		
	Make sure the battery is in the right way round. Remove the tab on the battery.	
Low Battery Dead Battery	When the battery is low the hearing aid will beep. When the battery has run out the hearing aid will go quiet.	
Full Battery	A battery lasts for 7 to 10 days . When the battery runs out you must change it.
