The team looking after you

Lung nurse specialist

The lung nurse specialist will be your **key worker**. The role of the key worker is to be a point of contact and to help co-ordinate your care. Your key worker can offer you support and advice about your care and treatment, even if you are attending a different hospital for your treatment. Your key worker will also be able to put you in touch with other professionals who can offer support and care.

Your key worker can be contacted from Monday to Friday, between 9.00am and 4.30pm, excluding Bank Holidays. If you need help or advice outside these hours you should contact your GP or out-of-hours GP service.

Multi-disciplinary team (MDT)

The team looking after you is known as the multi-disciplinary team (MDT and is made up of healthcare professionals who specialise in treating and caring for people with lung problems. They will discuss your case and recommend the most appropriate treatment and care for you. This may mean further tests or referral to another specialist team.
