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# Introduction

The aim of this booklet is to let you know about the support that is available to you following your diagnosis of hepatobiliary or pancreatic cancer.

These cancers include:

- pancreatic cancer
- ampullary cancer
- liver cancer
- bile duct cancer (cholangiocarcinoma)
- gall bladder cancer
- duodenal cancers

## Your nurse specialist (key worker)

You should have been given telephone contact details for your nurse specialist who is experienced about the type of cancer you have and can advise you about any concerns or problems you might have.

## Community palliative care nurse

In some situations you may need the support of your local community palliative care nurse, who specialises in controlling symptoms, if they arise. These symptoms may include pain, nausea (sickness), constipation, loss of appetite, weight loss or psychological stress. Your doctor or nurse specialist can refer you to your local nurse.

## **Free prescriptions**

If you have been diagnosed with cancer then you will be entitled to free prescriptions. Your nurse specialist or hospital Macmillan nurse can give you an application form to apply (FP92A).

# SR1 Form

If your medical team has told you that your cancer means that you have a limited life expectancy, you may be entitled to have an SR1 form completed for you. This means that you may:

- get benefits at a higher rate or get extra money
- start getting payments quicker than usual
