# Aftercare for an intravitreal injection in your eye

#### How will my eye feel after the injection?

The white of your eye may be slightly red and uncomfortable for a few days, especially around the injection area. This is normal and you may take painkillers if you have any discomfort.

#### How will it affect my vision?

Your vision in that eye will be blurred for a few days and you may see black spots (floaters) in your vision. This is normal and should disappear in a few days.

#### What advice do I need to follow after having the injection?

- Do **not** get your injected eye wet for 24 hours after your injection.
- Do **not** carry out energetic physical exercise for 24 hours after your injection.
- If you are a car driver and are eligible to drive, do not drive your car for 24 hours after your injection. You can ask staff for advice about your legal driving status if you are not sure.
- Use the eye drops as advised.

### What should I do if there is a problem?

Please contact the Eye Department if you have any of the following:

- sudden increase in redness, swelling or pain in the injected eye.
- loss of vision.
- new chest pain.
- slurred speech or weakness in any part of the body.
