

REFERRAL GUIDELINES



LYMPHOCYTOSIS



If evidence of:

- Unexplained fevers
- Weight loss (>1 stone in 6 months)
- Significant drenching night sweats
- Lymphadenopathy
- Hepatosplenomegaly
- Associated anaemia, thrombocytopenia or neutropenia

Urgent (2WW) referral to Haematology

Send 2 x EDTA for lymphocyte immunophenotyping to Immunology Department

If no requirement for urgent referral

- ?Smoker
- Assess if recent viral illness/ consider glandular fever screen If clear viral symptoms and symptoms resolve spontaneously, no need to repeat FBC

If no clause clear

Repeat FBC and request blood film in 4-6 weeks

If persistent lymphocytosis >5 x 10⁹/L

Send 2 x EDTA for lymphocyte immunophenotyping to Immunology Department

Follow advice given with result
