REFERRAL GUIDELINES



NEUTROPHILIA

Neutrophilia ---

Neutrophil count elevated

If chronic myeloid leukaemia is suspected you will be contacted by a haematologist to organise urgent admission or outpatient review and further investigations as indicated

Assess if there is a clear cause for this:

- Infection
- Inflammation
- Steroids
- Pregnancy
- Smoking
- Underlying neoplasia

If cause unclear check:

- CRP
- U&E
- LFT

....

- Serum Immunoglobulins
- Serum Free Lite assay
- ANA & Rheumatoid Factor
- PSA etc. led by history

Neutrophil count >15 X 10⁹/L, <u>persistent</u> at 3 months & unexplained:

Refer to Haematology
