## 4.1 PAS Replacement update (in mitigation of BAF Risks 4)

The Committee was briefed on the successful cut-over to the Trust's new Patient Administration System. The transition went smoothly from a technical point of view. The old system was taken down on Friday 20th June at 4.30 pm and services reverted to paper processes. The data was transferred from the old system over a 24-hour period and 50 million records moved over without loss. The new system went live on Saturday 21st June at 4pm. The data captured on paper was then entered onto the new system overnight. There has been no disruption to the national reporting schedule. Over the first week the Digital Team closed 2,000 incidents, a large proportion of which related to staff having the right permissions and a few issues around workflows. Support continues across the Trust for the next few weeks. The System will be tweaked in response to a few issues with a new release imminently.

The Committee congratulates all concerned and asks for regular updates as the System stabilises, and plans for optimisation.
